6.1	<ul> <li>MHCWP Capital Budget –</li> <li>The original capital budget was \$148.351M and is now \$130.351M.</li> <li>\$4M has been removed in 2012-13 from the Townsville SMHRU as the project has been deferred until 2013-14.</li> <li>\$14M has been removed as a result of the cancellation of the Redlands Adolescent Extended Treatment Unit and used for other QH projects.</li> <li>To date, budget overruns have occurred on the SMHRU and acute unit at Caboolture (approximately \$2M), the high secure unit at TPCMH (approximately \$300,000) and the Logan acute unit (currently \$1.4m).</li> <li>Final capital costs provided by HIO for 23 bed secure mental health rehabilitation unit and 20 bed acute unit at Caboolture is forecast to be \$24,235,562 from Project Services, still to be negotiated down by HIO.</li> <li>Any overall programme savings will be directed to make up the shortfall in the Townsville SMHRU.</li> <li>It is forecast the overall capital program will be delivered within budget. Tenders are coming in below the estimated budgets.</li> </ul>
