I've just had a chat to other workers in my office to see if they can come up with any creative solutions that might help your service. One suggestion was whether you could send me an email

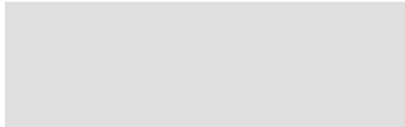

They are all crisis shelters and so have a worker on 24 hrs and can accommodate for around 3 months; however there are no guarantees that long term housing will be sourced in that timeframe.

I spoke with my CEO about your situation and she has suggested that the most appropriate action for you take would be to approach some fellow government departments. So the first thing you should do is contact the Dept. Housing and Public Works for housing for the [REDACTED] who need such urgently.

For support, she suggested that for your [redacted] you approach child safety services and for your [redacted] Disability Services and request appropriate support packages for them, as it is unlikely that any homelessness service will have the resources to provide intensive enough support for those [redacted] (i.e. 24 hr, very long term, etc). These government bodies should be able to provide the appropriate 24 hr care your [redacted] need.
