

There is no exclusion criteria. They are willing to provide trained Youth Mental Health Support Workers (seek and train) 24/7 if required in any location in Brisbane and surrounding areas. Unfortunately they do not providing Housing or Funding; we would be required to source and provide funding and accommodation.

As per model of risk mitigation I feel as thought this is the high level of support that is required. If this is an option that could be considered I would recommend that BAC staff provide outreach to adolescents and staff during transition.

It is in the process of being closed in January 2014, therefore we are transitioning our clients to suitable community services.

We are interested in connecting our young people with services that provide life skill development, vocational/educational supports, community integration and age-appropriate leisure programs. The majority of our young people experience varying levels of anxiety and have been disengaged with their local communities for a period of time while they have been receiving inpatient mental health care, including attending an alternate education program. We have clients that require the services outlined above as well as more intensive supports to monitor their safety, wellbeing and quality of life.

Could you please contact Vanessa Clayworth (Clinical Nurse Consultant) or Megan Hayes (Occupational Therapist) on or via email with any support programs you are able to offer or to discuss further. We hope you can appreciate the time sensitive nature of this matter and the vulnerability of the young people involved.


