Subject: Patient's ongoing care

Hi Anne,

I have contacted the APS and provided the context of the closure of BAC and whether it is ethically appropriate for patient's to continue seeing myself privately. I have documented time and date and person I spoke with. The APS advised that as long as the patient was provided with options; I am not deemed trying to "rally up business" (which he did not feel the context was indicative of) and the treating team was supportive of this treatment plan, that it was appropriate for *continuity of care* to continue to see patients under Section B.11 of our code of ethics, and did not see any problems with this ethically. I have attached the APS code of ethics for your reference.

At this point I deem it appropriate to continue to see [REDACTED] following [REDACTED] discharge from BAC and if this is what [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] family choose then I would be OK with accepting a referral from [REDACTED] GP. I will document the T/C with the APS in [REDACTED] chart.

Regarding [REDACTED] as previously discussed, in order to determine whether it is appropriate to continue seeing [REDACTED] I need to know what [REDACTED] other options are in order to determine what type of therapy process I may be able to offer [REDACTED] post discharge.

Regarding [REDACTED] discharge, I had an appointment with [REDACTED] today and discussed having one more review session (time at Barrett) before discharge. This would also mean [REDACTED] can attend the [REDACTED] next week. I am posing a discharge date of the 15th of November.
