

I thank you again for your and Mr Simpson's prompt responses to the Commission's further queries.

Further clarification in relation to the draft supplementary statement of Mr Simpson received yesterday is required. In particular, the Commission seeks clarification as to whether Mr Simpson received a 'community contacts list' from someone at the BAC other than Dr Brennan.

At paragraph 4 of the updated draft supplementary statement received yesterday, Mr Simpson stated he received only a mental health services risk screening tool (received on 14 January 2014) and a mental health services crisis intervention plan from Dr Brennan.

We note that during cross examination by Mr Fitzpatrick Mr Simpson acknowledged that "the combined effect of the three pieces of documentation [the above two documents and the report from the Specialist Disability Services Outreach and Assessment Team exhibited to Mr Simpson's original statement] was that by the end of January 2014 [he] had a full and adequate picture of (Transcript reference 21-105 lines 42 to 45).

In their report Prof. Kotze and Tania Skippen stated that the DSQ CM was provided with 'an extensive Community Contacts list, including upcoming appointments and recent actions'
